

Program Manager

Incumbent will perform and accomplish short-term, short-fused project work as needed relative to task orders in support of the U.S. Army's Tank Automotive Command (TACOM), Life Cycle Management Command (LCMC), Warren, MI.

The successful candidate will manage both INNOLOG and other subcontractor team members on proposals and task execution activities. Must be able to lead a group of individuals from multiple team member companies to provide timely, high quality engineering input to very time sensitive proposals. The successful candidate will manage all INNOLOG resources assigned to this engagement and lead the business development of TACOM business within an IDIQ contract. The ideal candidate will have several years of experience working in a similar capacity within the TACOM community and have extensive current knowledge of the TACOM organization and business environment.
